Safeguarding Policy

ASB Training have a duty of care to safeguard and promote the welfare of children, young people, vulnerable children and adults, and their customers, and is committed to ensuring safeguarding practice reflects statutory responsibilities, government guidance and complies with best practice and awarding organisation requirements.

The welfare and interests of children, young people, vulnerable children and adults, and customers are paramount in all circumstances. ASB Training aims to ensure that regardless of age, ability or disability, gender reassignment, race, religion or belief, sex or sexual orientation, socio-economic background, all customers:

- 1. Have a positive and enjoyable experience whilst taking part in services offered by ASB Training, in a safe environment.
- 2. Are protected from all forms of abuse whilst participating in the services provided by the organisation or outside of the services.

ASB Training acknowledges that some children, including disabled children and young people or those from ethnic minority communities, can be particularly vulnerable to abuse and we accept the responsibility to take reasonable and appropriate steps to ensure their welfare.

ASB Training will:

- 1. Promote and prioritise the safety and wellbeing of children, young people, vulnerable children and adults, and customers.
- 2. Ensure everyone understands their roles and responsibilities in respect of safeguarding and is provided with appropriate learning opportunities to recognise, identify, and respond to signs of abuse, neglect and other safeguarding concerns relating to children and young people.
- 3. Ensure appropriate action is taken in the event of incidents/concerns of abuse and support provided to the individual/s who raise or disclose the concern.
- 4. Ensure that confidential, detailed, and accurate records of all safeguarding concerns are maintained and securely stored.
- 5. Prevent the employment/deployment of unsuitable individuals and all those undertaking work for ASB Training must satisfy an enhanced Disclosure and Baring Service (DBS) check prior to undertaking work.
